

Thank you for trusting Vidant Health to care for you and your loved ones. The safety of our patients, visitors and team members is our top priority. As Vidant monitors and responds to the COVID-19 pandemic across North Carolina, we are taking steps to ensure the safety of all. Vidant remains vigilant with its screening process for all visitors, entry requirements and visitor restrictions by department. Vidant continues to closely track local data, including COVID-19 cases in our region and hospitals, and will adjust visitation restrictions accordingly.

In following the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) guidelines, visitors who need assistance due to a disability may have an additional individual with them when visiting a loved one in a Vidant Health facility to help navigate the current visitor guidelines.

All visitors will be screened and masked and asked to follow the entry requirements below.

Vidant is committed to accommodating safe, compassionate visitation and supporting patients' healing process.

Visitor Screening Process:

1. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days or waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test?

 Have you had close contact with a person with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
 Have you had any of these symptoms in the past 48 hours:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste of smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Any other symptoms of illness

Entry Requirements:

- 1. Temperature check: Temperature must be under 100°F degrees
- 2. Masking: Wear mask at all times in the building. Screeners will provide you a hospital mask if you do not have one. Cloth masks are permitted.
- 3. Hand washing: Visitors must gel or use hand sanitizer on entry.
- 4. Social distancing: Avoid close contact with others.
- 5. Limit personal belongings during your visit.
- Limit your visit to the patient room, and kindly do not go elsewhere in the hospital except for the Café.

If yes to any of the above - Visitor may not enter

Visiting Hours and Restrictions by Department All visitors must be screened and follow entry requirements:

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7 a.m. to 9 p.m.	 Two (2) healthy adult visitors screened and masked at all times. Visitors must stay in patient's room unless visiting the café. One (1) healthy adult visitor may be designated to stay overnight. Overnight visitors may not switch out with other visitors.
Open hours	 Maynard Children's Hospital and pediatric patients at all inpatient Vidant facilities welcome two (2) adult caregivers of the child at the bedside. Four (4) designated adult caregivers are identified by the child's legal guardian on admission and are able to visit the bedside throughout the duration of the child's stay. Please note: only two (2) visitors are allowed at the bedside at any time. Sibling visits are not permitted at this time; the health care team will work with families to facilitate virtual sibling visits as appropriate. For pediatric palliative or end-of-life care, additional visitation will be considered with approval from leadership based on the needs of the child.
Open hours	 Four (4) designated adult visitors, including the labor partner, are identified on admission and are able to visit the bedside throughout the duration of the stay. Please note: only two (2) visitors are allowed at the bedside at any time.
During time of appointment	• One (1) healthy adult visitor screened and masked at all times.
Open hours	 One (1) healthy adult visitor screened and masked at all times are able to visit procedural/surgical areas. Visitor will be allowed in waiting room as social distance requirements allow.
strictions Include:	
No visitors allowed in lobby	 No visitors allowed in lobby or waiting areas. Patients who are minors, or who fall within ADA guidelines, or require a visitor for clinical care or safety, may have one (1) healthy adult visitor screened and masked at all times in lobby or waiting areas. One (1) healthy adult visitor screened and masked at all times allowed once patient is placed in a room. Visitor may switch out with one (1) other visitor.
Open hours	 Family members who are screened and masked may visit with guidance from care team and should call the unit for guidance.
Open hours	• Visitors who are screened and masked may visit with guidance from care team and should call the unit for guidance.
No visitors allowed	 No visitors allowed. Ask unit for accommodations regarding virtual visits.
