



Everyone entering the facility must adhere to the following core infection prevention practices.

If you currently have a COVID-19 infection:

Do not visit in-person until you have gone at least 10 days since your first symptom or first positive test, have not had a fever for 24 hours and have been symptom-free.

If you currently have symptoms of COVID-19 infection:

Do not visit in-person until you have tested and are negative for COVID-19. If negative and still have respiratory symptoms, wear a face mask while in the facility.

If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the past 10 days, but have no symptoms:

Wear a face mask while you are in the facility.

You should be tested again:

1. At 24 hours after your exposure
2. If negative, test again in 48 hours
3. If negative again, test again in 48 hours

These instructions are in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Recommendations (CDC)
